Cascade Clamp - Cascade Manufacturing Company was established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943. They started out as a small machine shop at first employing 4 individuals. Sales for their first year of operation totaled 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless-steel valves, pipe fittings and other parts. Within 5 years of operation, the business had stretched to forty staff and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. These days, Cascade is among the leading international makers within the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's initial hydraulic cylinder allowed this young business to aggressively pursue new business opportunities. All through the final sixty years, the business of material handling has developed into a really advanced area with Cascade proudly playing a part in its progress. Cascade at present continues to develop as the premier provider of forklift accessories and various related products. The business feels certain in their ability to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding client's requirements in the future and remaining competitive within the international market.

During the 1950's, Cascade began to fabricate, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was constructed in 1956, so as to house all of the plant operations and offices in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current center of operations. Following 15 years of business, total workers reached one hundred eighty workers and sales had reached nearly two million three hundred thousand dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Murrieta the next manufacturing facility was built. The year 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In 1964, the company altered its name to the Cascade Corporation. Afterward in 1965, the company went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the continental US to the places Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already present plants in Springfield, Murrieta and Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are manufactured globally thanks to numerous subsidiary operations. In 1994, a new plant was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European command center. This plant is designed to be the ultimate customer service centre.

Continuing to develop, Cascade expanded their product offering further in 1996 and the year 1997 with the dramatic acquisition of 5 firms, along with the international leader in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
